The importance of obedience...

Old Testament

Joshua 1:7-9 – *Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go.*

The Example of Jesus

John 8:29 – *I always do what pleases Him.*

Phil 2:8 – *...he humbled himself and became obedient...*

Heb 5:8 – *Although he was a son, he learned obedience...*

The Commands of Jesus

John 14:23 – *If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching.*

Mark 1:17 – *Come, follow me...*

Mark 8:34 – *If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.*

New Testament Teaching

Col 3:17 – *And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus...*

1 John 2:3,4 – *We can be sure we know him if we obey his commands. The man who says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him.*
