### Review

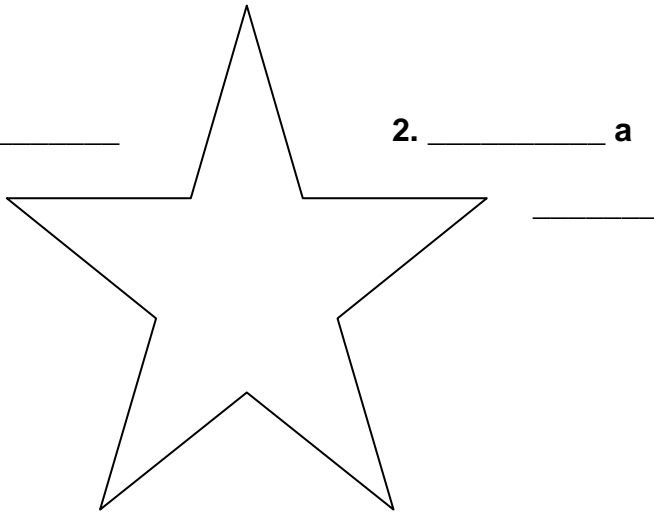
God is interested in how we handle ALL of our money.
